ORDER REQUIRING MEDICAL EXAMINATION AND COUNSELING

TO:

The Seattle-King County Department of Public Health has reason to believe that you are infected with HIV (the AIDS virus) and that by having unprotected sexual intercourse you are endangering the public health. Therefore, pursuant to chapter 70.24.024 RCW, **You are ordered to report immediately to Department of Public Health staff for HIV counseling and testing.**

This order is based on the following facts:

- 1) We have compelling evidence that you are infected with The Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV); and
- 1) That you are not telling your sexual partners that you are infected with HIV.

You are also ordered to do the following:

- 1) In the future you must never again engage in unprotected sex, and
- 2) Before engaging in sex you must always tell your sexual partner that you are infected with HIV.

If you choose to contest this order you are entitled to a hearing in King County Superior Court within 72 hours of receiving this document, and you may have an attorney at public expense, if necessary.

If you continue to have unprotected sexual intercourse or share needles after your counseling, we will order you to stop and will take whatever measures are necessary. This may include confinement.

ORDER REQUIRING COUNSELING

TO: (DOB:)

The Seattle-King County Department of Public Health has reason to believe that you are infected with HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus) and that you have been engaging in conduct that endangers the public health as defined in the Washington State Administrative Code [WAC 248-100-206 (1)(c)(i)].

Therefore, you are ordered to report for AIDS counseling [as defined in the Washington State Administrative Code, WAC 248-100-208(3)(9a-d)] on a weekly basis for as long as you are detained in the King County Correctional Facility unless hospitalization prevents you from doing so. AIDS counseling will be provided to you free of charge by the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health, or its designee, at times and places to be arranged.

You are also ordered to immediately and permanently refrain from the following conduct:

- 1) vaginal, oral, or anal intercourse without the use of a latex condom (this means that if you engage in any kind of intercourse, you must always use a latex condom), and
- 2) vaginal, oral, or anal intercourse with a partner who does not know that you are infected with HIV (this means that before you engage in any kind of intercourse, you must always first inform your sex partner that you are infected with HIV); and
- 3) sharing any paraphernalia associated with the injection of drugs; and
- 4) failing to disclose your HIV status to any person who might use drug-injecting paraphernalia that could possibly be contaminated with your blood (this means that you must tell anyone who might use your drug-injecting equipment that you are infected with HIV).


This order is based on the following evidence:

- 1) You are infected with HIV as indicated by laboratory tests performed on a blood specimen obtained by the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health on _____, at the King County Correctional Facility; and
- 2) On _____ and again on _____ you received counseling about how to prevent the spread of HIV infection; this counseling was provided by staff of the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health; and
- 3) On or about _____ you were arrested on charges relating to prostitution; and
- 4) In the absence of further counseling about HIV risk reduction, the department of public health believes that you will continue to engage in conduct that endangers the public health.

We will consider any future violations of "S.O.A.P." orders or arrests for "Offering & Agreeing to Prostitution" sufficient grounds to re-investigate this case.

If you choose to contest this order you are entitled to a hearing in King County Superior Court within 72 hours of receiving this document, and you may have an attorney at public expense, if necessary.

ORDER TO CEASE AND DESIST FROM CONDUCT ENDANGERING THE PUBLIC HEALTH

TO: (DOB:

The Seattle-King County Department of Public Health has reason to believe that you are infected with HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus) and that you have been engaging in conduct that endangers the public health as defined in the Washington State Administrative Code [WAC 248-100-206 (1)(c)(i)].

You are ordered to immediately cease and desist from the following conduct:

- 1) vaginal, oral, or anal intercourse without the use of a latex condom (this means that if you engage in any kind of intercourse, you must always use a latex condom), and
- 2) vaginal, oral, or anal intercourse with a partner who does not know that you are infected with HIV (this means that before you engage in any kind of intercourse, you must always first inform your sex partner that you are infected with HIV); and
- 3) sharing any paraphernalia associated with the injection of drugs; and
- 4) failing to disclose your HIV status to any person who might use drug-injecting paraphernalia that could possibly be contaminated with your blood (this means that you must tell anyone who might use your drug-injecting equipment that you are infected with HIV).

You are also ordered to report for AIDS counseling [as defined in the Washington State Administrative Code, WAC 248-100-208(3)(9a-d)] every two weeks for 90 days unless hospitalization prevents you from doing so. AIDS counseling will be provided to you free of charge by the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health, or its designee, at times and places to be arranged.

If you continue to have sexual intercourse or share needles, we will order you detained for intensive counseling. We will consider any future violations of "S.O.A.P." orders or arrests for "Offering & Agreeing to Prostitution" sufficient grounds to re-investigate this case.


This order is based on the following evidence:

- 1) You are infected with HIV as indicated by laboratory tests performed on a blood specimen obtained by the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health on March 26, 1992;
- 2) you have received counseling about how to prevent the spread of HIV infection; and
- 3) on or about December 1, 1992 you were arrested and incarcerated at the King County Correctional Facility for charges relating to prostitution; and
- 4) on or about December 1, 1992 you requested a pregnancy test at King County Jail Health Services, thereby indicating the probability of recent sexual intercourse without the use of a latex condom.

Therefore, this order is issued pursuant to RCW 70.24.024.

If you choose to contest this order you are entitled to a hearing in King County Superior Court within 72 hours of receiving this document, and you may have an attorney at public expense, if necessary.
